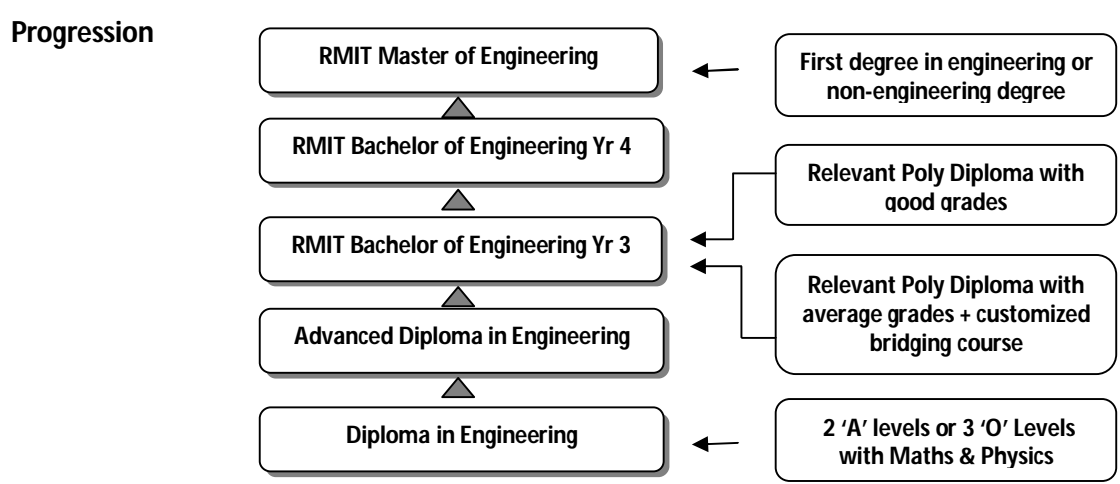

Intake Size The intake size for our Evening College programmes will be about 30 students.

For Whom The Diploma & Advanced in Engineering course is intended for those who wish to acquire technical knowledge, design skills and for those who wish to pursue a career in the engineering industry or for mature students with technical qualifications or with some work experience in the engineering, manufacturing or logistics industry looking to upgrade their studies.

The Diploma & Advanced Diploma in Engineering is also a recommended pathway to the Bachelor of Engineering awarded by Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (RMIT) University as it allows students to complete the diploma, advanced diploma and degree within 4 years.

Entry Criteria *Either*
 (i) Minimum 3 '**O**' levels (with Maths & Physics) or equivalent and **18 years** as of 31 December 2011 and **Diploma in Engineering Admissions Test (DENGAT)**
Or
 (ii) **2 'A' levels** or equivalent and **17 years** as of 31 December 2011



Course Structure Students are required to successfully complete the prescribed 8 core modules for the award of the Diploma before being eligible for progression to the Advanced Diploma in Engineering which has a further 8 modules.

Evening College (Part-time)

Classes will be time-tabled to be held 2-3 times a week between 6.45pm to 10pm. Besides lectures, students will also be required to attend tutorials and group discussions, personalised assisted learning sessions and pre-examination workshops conducted by RMIT visiting faculty which may be scheduled on weekends. All part time students are encouraged to maintain a minimum of 90% attendance for all lectures and tutorials.

Examinations & Assignments

Examinations will be held at the end of each term. Students will be expected to maintain a minimum 90% class attendance and to attempt all assignments and coursework, to be certified to sit for the final examinations held at the end of each term.
