<b>For Whom</b>	The 2 year Graduate Entry degree route is intended for students who hold a recognised first degree. The 3 year normal Entry degree route is intended for students who have attained a minimum of 2 'A levels' or equivalent. The LLB degree is suitable for those who wish to develop a critical awareness of the common law legal tradition and be able to apply analytical and problem solving skills in a range of legal and non-legal settings.

<b>Entry Criteria</b>	<i>Graduate Entry</i> A recognised first degree completed in a minimum of 3 years on a full-time basis. <i>Normal Entry</i> (i) 2 'A' levels or equivalent + 3 'O' levels (with English) and 17 years as of 1 September 2010 Or (ii) Poly Diploma + 'O' level English and 17 years as of 1 September 2010 Or (iii) Any other recognised qualification as stated by the University
<b>Course Structure</b>	<i>Graduate Entry</i> Students will be required to successfully complete 9 full units to graduate.  <i>Normal Entry</i> Students will be required to successfully complete 12 full units to graduate.
<b>Subjects</b>	Law of Contract, Criminal Law, Common Law, Reasoning & Institutions & Public Law
<b>Foundation Week</b>	<b>Foundation Week – 5 Sept 2011 to 9 Sept 2011</b> The Foundation Week will cover essential topic areas on study skills and Legal English skills, reading cases and statutes and guidance on exam techniques.
