Entry Criteria	<i>Either</i> (i) Minimum 4 'O' levels (with English) or equivalent and 18 years as of 1 September 2011 and Diploma in Law Admissions Test (DLAT) <i>Or</i> (ii) 2 'A' levels or equivalent + 3 'O' levels (with English) and 17 years as of 1 September 2011 <i>Or</i> (iii) Poly Diploma and 17 years as of 1 September 2011
Course Structure	All applicants will be required to sit for the Diploma in Law Admissions Test and be offered a place on the Diploma. Upon successfully completing the Diploma in Law, students would be eligible for the 2 nd year of the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) awarded by the University of London.
