Fees

The Stansfield College registration and course fee per year (excl. GST) is as follows:

The above fees inclusive of 7% GST is 5,136. Registration fee and 1st instalment of \$1,070 is due during registration submission and the balance is payable in 7 monthly instalments of \$535.

The above registration fee is inclusive of medical insurance and escrow admin charges. Under the new EDUTRUST regulation fee protection under escrow and medical insurance is compulsory and Evening College students are given this free of cost.

The above fees do not include the University registration, examination fees or cost of textbooks and other miscellaneous costs.
